Through Intel's Matching Gift Program, Intel matches employee and retiree donations to most educational institutions including:

- Four year college or university, Technical or community college, School or university foundation (must have 501c3 status), K-12 schools, PTO's, PTA's and other support organizations for K-12 schools (must have 501c3 status).

The Intel Foundation will match donations made by employees and retirees of up to \$10,000, at a rate of 50% of the donation (max \$5,000 contribution from Intel per employee each year.)
